Property Tax Deductions

A deduction of \$250 is available to those residents age 65 years of age or older, who have owned their homes since October first of the previous tax year, lived in the state for two years and whose income (excluding Social Security or other similar government pension) does not exceed \$10,000. For additional information, call your local Tax Assessor's Office.

Cleanout & Move-out Fees

Contents from entire cleanout of dwellings cannot be put at curb until a fee of \$250 is paid to the Township of Berkeley and arrangements for collection have been made with the Department of Public Works. Mattresses must be enclosed in bags.

Garbage and trash are NOT to be placed at curb prior to 4:00 PM the night before pickup.

Dues Assessments

Second quarter dues payment of 2026 are due April 1, 2026. A late fee of \$15 will be added to your account on the 1st of the next month if dues are not paid on time. Association dues assessments are payable on or before the first day of a given quarter. To ensure that your dues payments are posted correctly, your payment must be accompanied by a dues coupon containing all of the required information. Be sure your information is legible. Payments may be sent to the Clubhouse by mail, brought to the Treasurer's office or placed in the dues box on the main floor of the Clubhouse. **Dues coupons are available at the Clubhouse and are published in The Sentinel.**

As a homeowner, your obligation to pay dues continues as long as you own your home and it is the homeowner's obligation to pay dues for renters. Individuals residing in your home with you on a permanent basis ("permanent" defined as a stay of more than 90 days) must be 19 years of age or older and are obligated to abide by the Association's governing documents. Also, remember, if you own more than one home, each property is subject to dues.

Dues Coupons

January 1, 2026 homeowners dues are \$72 per quarter per living unit. Payments are to be made at the beginning of the quarter. January 1, 2026, April 1, 2026, July 1, 2026 and October 1, 2026. If you pay semi annually the payment would be \$144 on January 1, 2026 and July 1, 2026. Annual payments are \$288 due on January 1, 2026. Make checks payable to Silver Ridge Park West Homeowners Association and mail or drop off in the mail slot at the Clubhouse, 145 Westbrook Dr., Toms River, N.J. 08757

Note: All payments must be accompanied by a fully completed dues coupon. A late fee of \$15 will be added to your account on the first of the next month after the due date if dues are not paid on time.

Meeting Minutes

February 9, 2026

President: Meeting called to order at 3:00pm. Thank you very much for coming this afternoon. Can all please stand for the Pledge of Allegiance.

Pat Lima: Opening prayer

President: Thank you, Pat.

President: Roll Call: President. Here. Vice President. sick. Secretary sick. Section 5, Here. Section 6. Here. Section 7. Absent. Section 8. Here. Section 9. Excused. Section 10. Here. Section 11. Absent. We do not have a quorum. We will not be able to vote on any matters tonight.

President: Good afternoon everyone. We had a fire inspection and failed in two aspects; Knox box and fire zone striping. A Knox box is a small vault type box mounted on the front of the building with a master key to allow the fire department to enter the building without damage. A signal is sent to the truck to activate a locked key in the cab that opens the Knox box. We asked for an extension on the striping violation until the weather breaks, it was approved by the Fire Official.

Resident: I have a question about the sign out front.

President: This is not the time for resident's question and answers. Please let me finish my report and Association business. Electrical repairs are almost complete, we are at about 95% of full restoration. Outside lights, some receptacles and circuits are not completely working. This will be totally completed tomorrow and inspected by the Township Electrical Official. The cost of total repairs for the water service and electrical service is \$11,900 plus cost of the Township permits. Insurance covered all but our \$1000 deductible and the Township charges, around \$150. This entire mess was caused by a frozen water main, which defrosted and flooded the mechanical room, drenching the electrical panels. Repairs to the water service was a new water meter, several isolation valves, piping and a pressure relief valve. The entire electrical service, main and sub panels, needed replacement. The boilers were inspected and found to be okay. However, the water heater needs to be replaced because of age, The gas control valve is corroded and inoperable. This is not a result of the leak, it is from age. The water heater is about 15 years old and we will be replacing it in the near future.

Regarding the snow, please be prepared before the storm. We were given plenty of notice of the snow and ice storm. The Township was contacted numerous times about streets not being plowed. If your street or court is not plowed, call the Township DPW. We do not plow the streets or have any control over it.

Vice President: No report

Secretary: No report

Treasurer, given by President: The CD was renewed at M&T Bank for 6 months, they had the best rate currently. We will be opening another Reserve Account, since most of the one-time Capital Contribution

fee has been going into the Repair & Replace account for the past year. Collection of outstanding dues continues.

Trustee reports.

Marybethe M., Trustee Section 5: Nothing to report

Brian K., Trustee Section 6: I had a phone call from the homeowner that the wrong garbage and recycling schedule was posted in the Sentinel

President: That issue has already been addressed. A Robo Call was sent out to disregard the schedule that was in the February Sentinel.

Bob S., Trustee, Section 8: There were no new violations.

Tom K., Trustee, Section 10: Quiet

President: Since this is the Homeowners quarterly meeting, we will do away with committee and club reports.

Resident: When will the sign out front be fixed.

President: At this time the sign is not a priority. As I stated, we still do not have the building back running at 100% after the water disaster in the mechanical room. All electrical circuits have not been restored. We are at about 95%. Outside lights and parking lot lights are not working. All wall receptacles are not working.

Resident: So, when will it be fixed.

President: As I said it is not on the top of the list. We still have to replace the hot water heater and finish the electrical work.

Resident: So, when are you going to make it a priority?

President: Not now

Resident: When?

President: I do not know. There is a rumor going around that the sign was burned up, because the electric company hired to run a new electric line to the sign supplied the wrong voltage to the sign. It needs to be looked into.

Resident: You don't know who did the work? There is no paperwork?

President: No, I do not know who did the work and those that know what happened are not saying anything, Nobody, knows anything. Nobody is saying anything.

Resident: Why don't you investigate it? There must be a check made out to somebody

President: As I said it is not the number 1 issue to take care of right now. Why don't you investigate it?

Resident: Who can I talk to about what happened to the sign.

President: The previous president.

Resident: Who was that?

President and several other residents: Maria Brush

Brian Trustee Section 6: As has been a problem in the past documents disappear when a new administration takes over. It takes time to figure things out. They have their hands full.

President: Thank you, Brian, let's move on from the sign.

Vivian E.: Whatever happened to the flags that were on the fire hydrants to mark where they are when covered with snow.

Vivian E.: Can we fix the back door downstairs?

President: Yes, we are looking into fixing or replacing them all. We got some outrageous prices up to \$65,000.00. So, we are still looking.

Resident: They are in bad shape.

President: I know

Bill K.: I read in the Sentinel that the Recreation Committee is taking over the Veterans breakfast.

President: Yes, that is true.

Bill K.: Why? The Men's Club has done it for the past two years and everyone has fun and enjoys it.

President: Because two women from the Women's Club complained at two meetings the Recreation Committee didn't help. Even though the committee hasn't been around for the past two years. Also, nobody said help was needed, I thought the Men's Club had it all under control.

Lorraine L.: I don't think it's fair to blame Maria for the sign!

President: She was the President at the time. She is responsible for it.

Any more questions? No? Thank you everybody for coming out

Motion to adjourn? Second? Second. All in favor? Aye. Thank you everybody.

ARCHITECTURAL CONTROL COMMITTEE

The Architectural Control Committee is a standing committee and operates under the guidance of the SRPW HOA By-Laws, Declaration of Covenants and Restrictions, and Rules and Regulations.

According to Article V, Section 1 of the Declaration of Covenants and Restrictions: No building or other structure, fence, wall, swimming pool or any other structure, either of a permanent or temporary character, shall be erected, moved on, installed, commenced or maintained, upon the properties nor shall any exterior addition to or alteration be made to any existing building or structure unless the plans and specifications thereof, showing the nature, kind, shape, height, materials and location of same, shall have been submitted to and approved in writing as to harmony, as to exterior design, and location of surrounding structures and topography, by the Architectural Control Committee of the Association which shall consist of either (1) The Board of Trustees of the Association, or (2) a committee composed of not less than three (3) persons appointed by the Board of Trustees of the Association.

Process by the Committee Members:

1. Provide HOA paperwork and assist homeowner with preparation of same.
2. Do preliminary site survey and discuss with homeowner planned improvements.
3. Collect homeowner's completed paperwork.
4. Present paperwork to HOA officers for approval and be available to discuss with officers.
5. Collect officer's signatures for approval.
6. Provide homeowner with copies of approval to proceed.
7. Maintain contact with homeowner.
8. Resident to contact Architectural Control upon completion of job Review project upon completion.
9. Return completed paperwork to HOA office for the permanent files.
10. Maintain tracking worksheet with progress.

Violations of the HOA Covenants and Restrictions:

1. STOP WORK order to cease work in progress
2. Delay in approval of proposed work
3. Possible non-approval of proposed work
4. Fines by the HOA for non-compliance, not to exceed \$100 per violation
5. Fines by Berkeley Township for code violations

Berkeley Township Construction Permits

No construction permit shall be issued for the alteration of the exterior of any residence or addition to such residence, or construction of accessory structures located within any planned residential retirement community, unless the application for such permit is accompanied by a written statement issued by the association organized under subsection 35-101.12 of this section, indicating whether the association has approved the proposed improvement. In the absence of such approval the Construction Official may if otherwise required to issue the permit pursuant to the Uniform Construction Code note on the permit that the applicant must obtain such approval before beginning construction.

Scams that Target the Military

Active Service Members and Veterans



Current Scams to Watch Out For

Veterans Charities Scams: Fraudsters posing as veterans or members of veterans' organizations are soliciting donations for a supposed organization supporting veterans, service members, or military families. However, the supposed charities are fake and the money goes right into the pockets of fraudsters.

Tip: Only give to charities you know and trust rather than those that solicit you at home!

Veterans Affairs, Defense Finance and Accounting Services ("DFAS"), or VA Hospital Phishing Scams:

Veterans receive a phone call from a fraudster posing as a representative of the Department of Veterans Affairs, DFAS, or a Veterans Affairs Hospital. Veterans then are asked to provide personal information, including their social security number, in order to "update their files."



Tip: Never provide personal information to anyone over the phone or by email, especially unique identifiers such as a social security number or credit card number.

U.S. Army CID Phishing Scams:

Cyber criminals are attempting to pose as members of the U.S. Army Criminal Investigation Command ("CID") or some other military investigative organization, and emailing members of the military and their families, telling them that they have supposedly discovered fraudulent activities with a company that the victim had contact with.

These criminals then ask the victim to provide personal information, including sensitive financial information, so that these investigators can determine whether a person's identity or financial security has been "compromised."

Tip: Soldiers, civilians and family members are all advised to delete such e-mails immediately upon receipt. Do not respond to the e-mail and report it to the U.S. Army CID's "Report a Crime" branch at usarmy.belvoir.usacidc.mail.crime-tips@mail.mil.

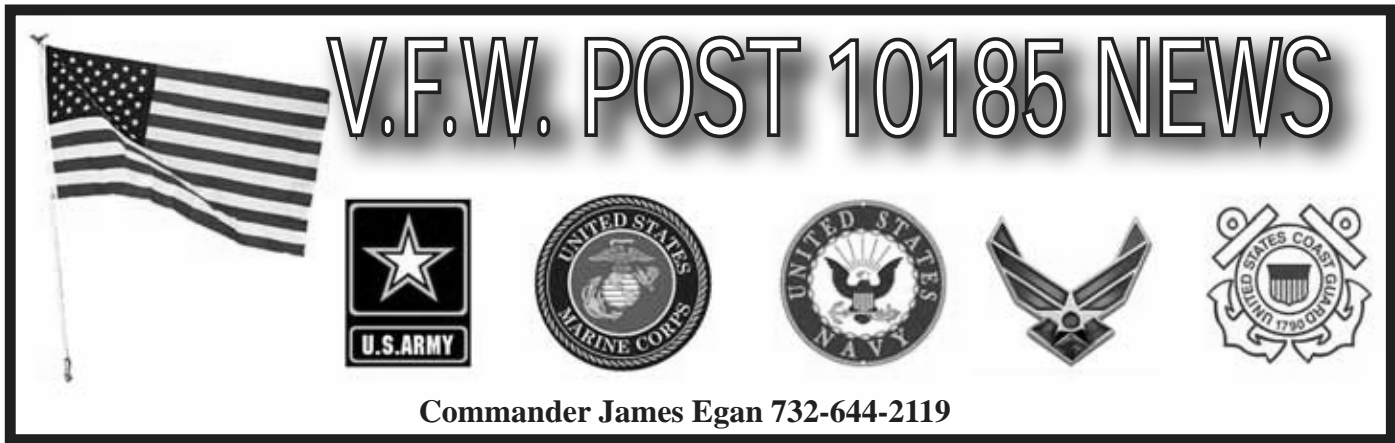

Utility Payment Assistance Programs

APPLY FOR UTILITY ASSISTANCE PROGRAMS TODAY!

Universal Service Fund (USF) provides monthly credits of up to \$200 per month for household natural gas and electric bills. USF also offers forgiveness of overdue utility balances through the USF-Fresh Start Program. Through Fresh Start, each month a USF customer pays their current charges in full, a portion of the balance owed at time of enrollment is forgiven. Fresh Start is available once every five years. Apply for USF online at: www.nj.gov/dca/dcaid or call **800-510-3102** to find a local application agency, or request a home visit due to medical reasons. Learn more at: www.nj.gov/bpu/assistance/programs/.

Home Energy Assistance Program (HEAP) provides grants for household heating costs (electric, gas and deliverable fuels), heater repairs, medically-necessary cooling, and heating expenses included in rent. Self-screen for eligibility and apply online at: www.nj.gov/dca/dcaid or call **800-510-3102** to have an application mailed to you, find a local application agency, or request a home visit due to medical reasons. Income limits are the same as USF. More information at: www.energyassistance.nj.gov

Payment Assistance for Gas and Electric (PAGE) provides grants for overdue natural gas and electric bills for low- and moderate-income households. If you are income eligible for USF or HEAP, you must apply for those programs first before seeking supplemental assistance from PAGE. Winter Termination Program (WTP) protects certain categories of customers from disconnection of gas, electric, water and/or sewer service during the winter months of November 15 – March 15. Eligible customers include those who receive USF, HEAP, Lifeline, PAAD, Work First New Jersey/TANF, General Assistance (GA), SSI, or water assistance programs. Customers unable to pay due to circumstances beyond their control, may also request the protection WTP. To enroll, please call your utility company and request WTP protection. For more information, or to file a complaint, call the New Jersey Board of Public Utilities at **800-624-0241** or visit www.nj.gov/bpu.

If you are in danger of utility shut off, or if you are currently disconnected, apply for the programs above and inform your utility company immediately.

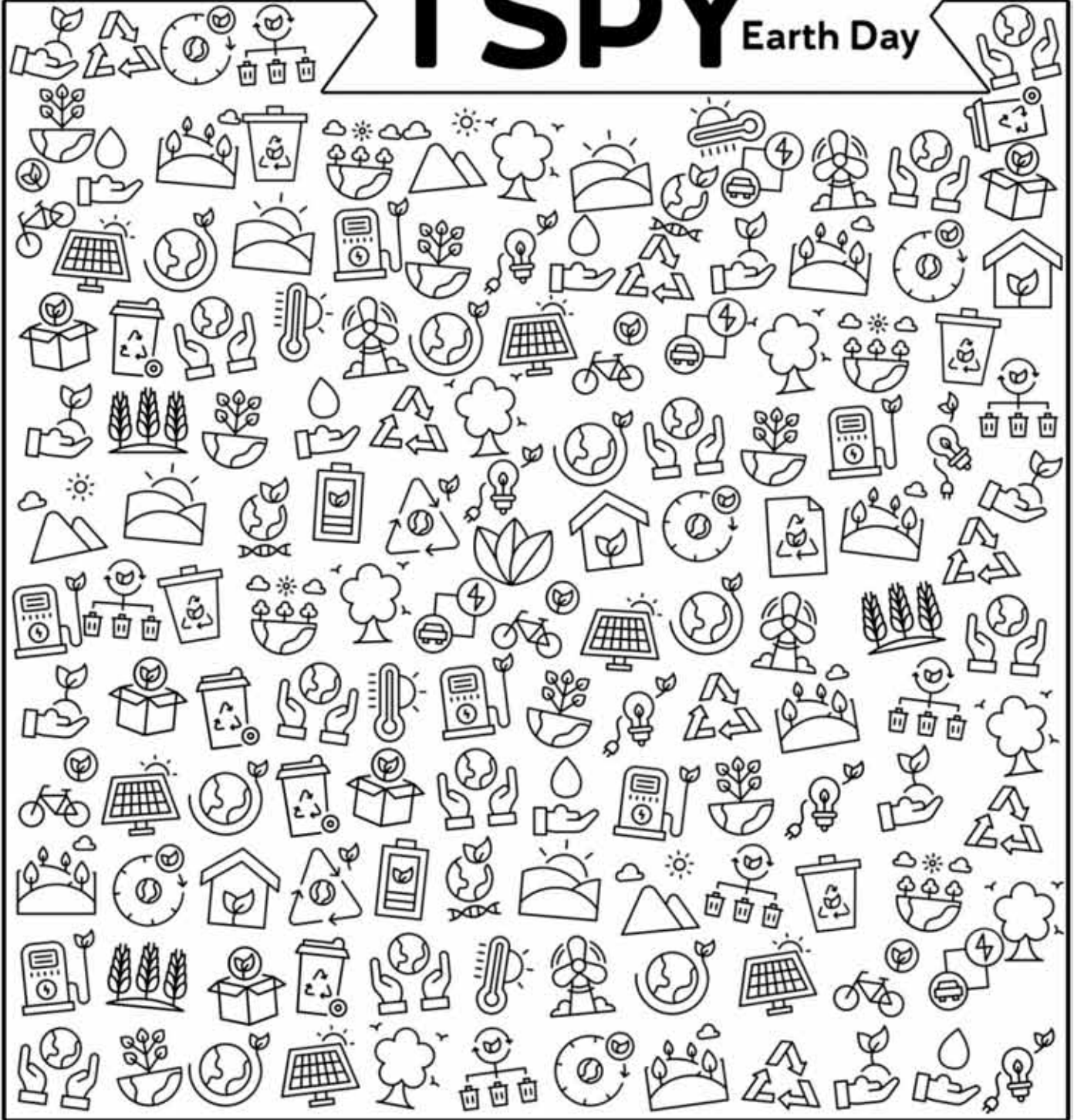

Easy Easter Bunny Pots



The perfect budget friendly Easter craft that works as a handmade gift or place setting for your Easter table!

Materials Needed

- Small pots
- Fake greenery or green felt/paper (a great last minute alternative - simply cut your felt/paper to look like grass at the top)
- Small and large pom poms
- A hot glue gun (you can also use craft glue - you'll just need to hold it together to stick it)
- Felt for the feet (you can use two colours of felt to make the feet and paw prints - or you can paint on the paws)
- Easter eggs or Easter treats to put inside



Instructions

First you'll want to cut two feet out of felt. I freehanded these, making these just a bit smaller than the pom pom "bottom".

Next, add paw prints to one side of your bunny feet. You could do these by glueing on smaller pieces of felt - but I find the easiest way is to paint them on. I added one big paw pad and four little bunny toes to each foot.

Next you'll want to heat your hot glue gun up and get your pom poms ready. I used a small and large pom pom in the same colour to make my bunnies - but you could mix it up and use different colours.

Add some glue to the bottom of your small "tail" pom pom and attach it to your larger pom pom, pressing them together to ensure they stick.

Once your bunny bottoms are stuck together, start getting your greenery ready. Mine came in small bunches which I cut into smaller pieces and glued to the inside of my pot. You want to arrange your greenery towards the back of the pot so you have plenty of room to add your Easter eggs or treats!

Once you've got your greenery in, it's time to add your bunny! Add some glue to the front of your pot, ready to add your bunny.

Carefully attach your bunny "bottom" to the front of your pot, ensuring your tail is in the right place. You want it to look like the bunny is head down in the pot with its bottom sticking up so the tail should be at the top.

Next, attach your feet by adding some glue to the other side of your felt feet and attaching them to the pom pom (that is, the side without your little paw prints). You want the feet to hang over the edge of the pot as shown in the photo.

Once your feet are on and your glue has set, it's time to add your treats! We filled our pots with chocolate Easter eggs, being careful not to knock off our little bunny!

Once your pots are filled, it's time to gift! You could gift these as is, or wrap each one in some cellophane, tying them with ribbon and adding a gift tag. These bunny pots would also make the perfect placecard holders for your Easter table. Why not add a little mini "garden stake" to the top of the pot with each person's name. Simply get a skewer or toothpick, cut it to size and add some paper or washi tape to make a banner to add each person's name.

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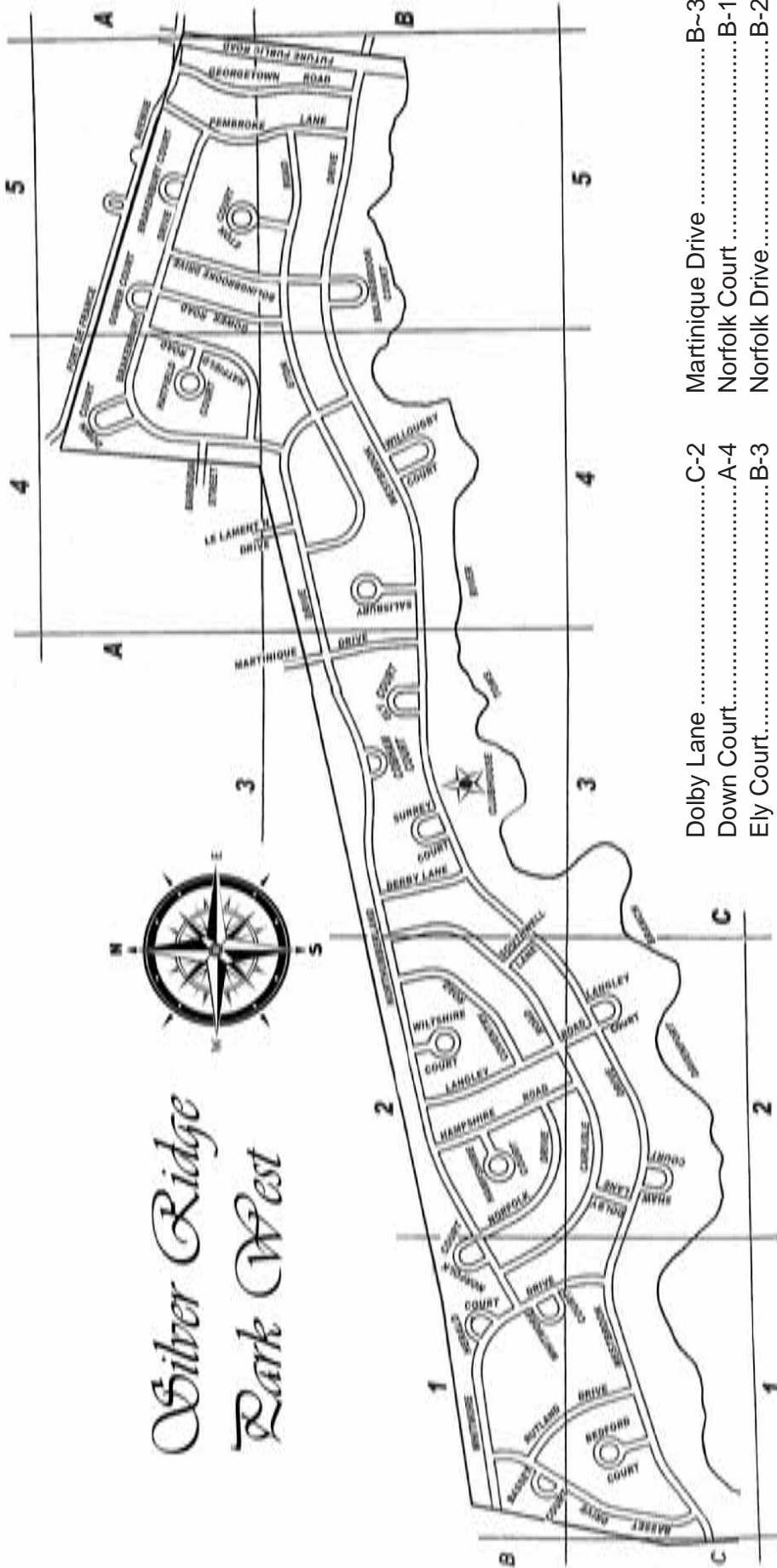

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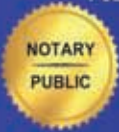
